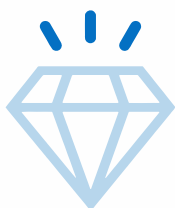
Vision

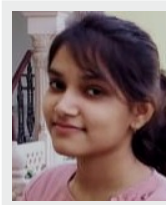

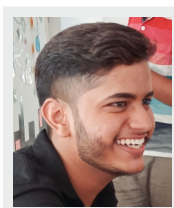


“ Discovering the confidence ”



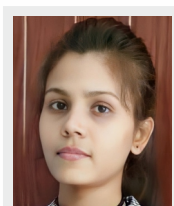
